Dr. Nikolaos Plevris is an OBGYN consultant, director of the 1st Gynaecological clinic, department of robotic and laparoscopic surgery of Metropolitan General Hospital, Athens, Greece.

He is a proctor for gynecological surgeries for Intuitive Da Vinci surgical robots.

He has assisted in initiating robotic programs in gynecology in different countries of South-Eastern Europe. His department acts as an epicenter for robotic surgery in gynecology with visiting surgeons from different countries.

His clinical interests include robotic surgery, gynecological oncology, sentinel node surgery, cervical screening/colposcopy, and vaccination programs.

His Ph.D. thesis on hereditary ovarian cancer resulted in publications upon specific genes predisposing HBOC (Hereditary Breast Ovarian Cancer) for the Greek population.

He has completed the RCOG (Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists) ATSM gynecological oncology program and acquired the BSCCP (British Society for Colposcopy and Cervical Pathology) accreditation.

He is an active speaker at national and international conferences.

## Advanced Robotic Surgery

Dr. Nikolaos Plevris has been certified as a "Master Surgeon in Robotic Surgery" (MSRS) for gynecological robotic surgeries by the prestigious international surgical certification body, the Surgical Review Corporation (SRC).

### First Certification in Greece

Dr. Plevris is the first Gynecological Surgeon in Greece to receive this specific certification. This follows an extensive evaluation process, inspection, and adherence to the strict protocols set by the Surgical Review Corporation.

The awarding of the certification was completed after a months-long documentation and monitoring of 125 robotic gynecological cases at the Metropolitan General Hospital. It also involved checks for adherence to specific procedures before, during, and after the surgical operation, as well as the monitoring of complication rates and readmission indices.

The certification is the result of long-term experience in robotic gynecological surgeries, adherence to strict procedures, and the adoption of high-quality criteria.
